A comprehensive Blended Diploma Course in Montessori Teachers Training from IMTC. (For children age 3-6 years)

A blended program of LIVE 'Online' and 'Contact program'

The purpose of this training course (Indian Montessori Training Courses Outreach, Rajkot) is to take the Montessori out of the strongholds of Bangalore & Chennai to spread the method in the other parts of the country. Which can be done only with a help of a **strong training course!**

We have taken advantage of Technology (Online classes) and passion of some of the Montessorians to hold the space for 'Offline' part of the course.

Here's a short introduction to the course design and content.

The Course Content

- Philosophy and Principles of Montessori Method and Child Psychology.
- Practical Demonstrations Classes (Explanation and demonstration of Montessori apparatus and its scientific nature)
- Belonging to the Areas of Exercises of Practical Life, Sensorial, Language, Arithmetic and Items of Human Culture.
- Preparation of educational materials.
- Observation in Houses of Children.
- Practice with the Montessori Materials.
- A first hand experience of making materials through handwork.

The Application process

1. Fill in the Google form.
2. E-mail a scanned copy of the following to imtc.outreach@gmail.com
 1. 10th Standard certificate.
 2. The certificate of your highest Educational Qualification.

3. Aadhar card / Pan card / Voters id / Driving license
 4. Handwritten life sketch (With information other than in the application form)
 5. Medical certificate of health and fitness (Signed and stamped by your doctor)
 6. The proof of payment of the registration fees of ₹ 1,000 (QR code in the Google form.)
3. You will need to get two Passport size photos and fill in a detailed form on the first official meeting at the centre.

The Course schedule

- The course will be held from ***4th January 2026 to Mid December 2026.***
- The online lectures and demonstration classes will be held five days a week, ***Monday- Friday.***
- The practical sessions will be held on the ***second Friday, Saturday & Sunday***, of the month at the practice centre.
- The online lectures are held between ***10am- 1 pm*** with half an hour break in between. Practical sessions are from ***10:00 am to 4:00 pm on the Second Sat & Sun. 3-5 pm on that Fri.*** {Practice weekend may change in case of Gazetted holidays}
- All the sessions will be conducted in English
- Online sessions will be held live on Zoom.
- Students MUST keep their ***video ON*** and mike on mute and be present in front of the camera. Rules for Online sessions will be shared before the commencement of the sessions. Students are expected to adhere to the rules.

Additional Assistance

There will be Mentors for the students attending the courses. A Mentor is an experienced and approved Montessorian from IMTC. She will be available at individual level for guidance, counselling and clarification for the students.

Practice

- The supervised practice will be held on ***the above mentioned days*** at the centre.
- Students will get to practice with the materials for a real life experience of these scientifically prepared materials.
- In case a Student cannot take up the practice session/practical exams, he/she is permitted to register for the practice/practical exams within a maximum of one year from the date of the written exams.
- 100 % attendance in Practicals (Offline sessions) is essential to qualify for the final examination.

Hand work

- Hand work is an essential part of IMTC. Students are expected to complete this work in the given time frame. It involves construction, cutting, pasting, colouring, drawing, painting, stitching etc.
- Resource persons will help the students to understand the nature of work in the sessions.

Material File

- Material files are the files containing details of Presentations (demonstrations) of each material.
- It is mandatory for each student to submit the assigned presentation/topic every month on the date assigned.
- Students will submit the soft copy of the assigned topic in the prescribed format.
- The material files will then be *hand written* for effective learning.
- Students can take help of Mentor for guidance.

Observation

- Observation will be organized in person at select Montessori Houses of children in **Bangalore**. *{Students are required to observe in a recognised Montessori house of children, with mixed age group and a Directress from a recognised training course.}*
- 10 working days in February 2026 and 10 in August/September 2026. *{Dates will be announced closer to start of the course.}*
- It is mandatory for students to complete stipulated number of hours of observation and submit a written report when required.

Tests and Examinations

- There will be two periodical tests and few assignments to be written during the course.
- Attendance is compulsory for tests and examinations to receive the Diploma.

Final Examinations

- There are **two written papers** covering all the topics discussed. One paper deals with all theory and the other on Psychology. Both papers will cover practical application of the Method also ie the four areas.
- After the written examinations, there will be an **oral and practical examination** after around 15 days of intense, offline practice sessions. This will be held late November/early December 2026.
- **90% attendance** is mandatory in Online sessions and **100% in practical** to qualify for the written exams.
- **All the assignments, tasks** and the handwritten file must have been submitted punctually and approved.
- Performance in written tests must be satisfactory.
- Student should have **completed observation** as stipulated by IMTC.

- A student whose Diploma is withheld for any incomplete work (including exams) has to finish the same within the time stipulated by the Director. (not beyond one year)
- In case a student does not pass written **or** Practical exams, he/she may appear for the next immediate examination conducted by IMTC.
- A student is permitted to make only one more attempt to appear for exams in case he/she could not 'pass' in the first attempt. There is no provision for third attempt.

Award of Diploma

- The Diploma will be awarded by the Indian Montessori Centre. The President, the Director of Board of Studies and the Director of the Courses will sign the Diploma.
- The Diploma is awarded only to those who have successfully completed the written papers (two of them), have required % of attendance in Theory, Practical and Observation sessions, prepared the materials and cleared the oral and practical examinations as per the procedures of IMC.

Challenges and solutions

- Every care is taken to ensure smooth functioning of IMTC considering the spirit and the intent.
- In case there are any challenges due to unforeseen situations, the Director will hold talks with the concerned students and arrive at amicable solution.
- However, with regard to any dispute about written or practical exams, the decision of the External Examiner is final.

Health

- Students are suggested to maintain a good physical health as a requirement to do this course and also while working with Children.
